you take care of any changes you need.


As always we have a steady calendar





GETTING TO KNOW YOUR PCA SUNCOAST REGION, ONE MEMBER AT A TIME



10 questions for Norman Sippel, Suncoast PCA member for 2 years

PORSCHE PROFILE: What is your occupation and in which part of the Suncoast Region do you live?

NORMAN SIPPEL: I am the Associate Publisher of Vintage Motorsport magazine. We live in Palm Harbor.

PP: How did you first become a Porsche/Suncoast enthusiast?

NS: Bill and Mary Caldwell, who we knew from the BMW CCA, were most influential in informing us about the club and getting us to join.

PP: What models of Porsches have you owned and what do you currently drive?

NS: Let's start with the almost-owned 1965 356C Cab that I ordered for \$4,264 when I returned from active duty after college. Sadly, the company I went to work for soon was on strike long enough that I went through the savings that would have paid for that new Porsche when it arrived. Order canceled.

Over the years, I drove many Porsches in my capacity as an auto journalist. They ranged from a 924 Turbo to a 2006 Carrera Turbo that I drove at Watkins Glen when it was introduced. Somehow I was paired with Hurley Haywood for the track drive. And, yes, he was faster than me. The Porsche was faster on the back straight than my MGB race car by 18 mph when I drove it, and 39 mph faster

when Hurley drove it.

When I decided to sell my Turner and Alfa race cars in 2012, I went looking for a Porsche. I quickly found a white/beige/black 2009 Targa 4S in Palm Springs, CA. By the time I sold the first race car a few weeks later, the Targa was gone. Thus began a six-month search that ultimately took us to Reeves with plans to buy a new 991 coupe. "Road Block!" While there, we saw and bought a Maserati GranTurismo instead. Awesome car! BUT no club activities. A year ago, I found a '97 white/beige/black Targa in Laguna Beach with 17,500 miles on it. Bought it!

PP: What is your "dream" car?

NS: The "New" Targa 4S.

PP: In which PCA/Suncoast activities or events do you participate?

NS: Primarily social and tour events, although I did a DE at Sebring last year with the Maserati and plan to do one with the Targa.

PP: Is there a Suncoast event in which you excel – or would like to excel?

NS: Owning a 993 that has such little mileage and is in nearly new condition, Concours are appealing right now.

PP: What interests you, other than

Porsche and the PCA?

NS: My wife, Penny, and I like to travel. We went to Machu Picchu and Spain last year. Anyone for Santorini next year? And, we love the opera. Sherrill Milnes and his wife Maria Zouves are neighbors and good friends. Coincidentally, her mother and Penny's came from the same Greek island.

PP: Do you prefer the direct way home or the twists and turns route?


NS: Having lived many years in the Northeast where roads follow old deer trails, I LOVE the twisties. Add in 12 years of racing vintage sports cars, and the answer is clear - twist & shout! I can't wait for the Smokies Tour in October.

PP: In your opinion, how could Porsche improve the driving experience?

NS: Improve? Porsche and PCA have done great jobs of delivering fantastic products and providing venues in which to enjoy them. Rock on!

PP: Do you have a Porsche story you'd like to share with our readers?

NS: I'll never forget the look on my daughter's face the day I picked her up from grammar school in a Bottle Green 930 test car, and we then did a couple of 0 - 100 runs. She was wide-eyed with amazement as she was pushed back in her seat - immobilized.

know we need numbers on our cars when we drive at an autocross, or a DE. Otherwise, all the fallen cone calls at autocrosses would sound a lot like, "Station 4, One cone ... Um, on the Porsche??" I get why we need numbers. Generally, we get to select those numbers. That got me thinking, "Why do people have the particular number they do?" So I asked a few of our members. Some answers were along the lines of, "Well I wanted #11 so it would be easy to make with blue tape." Others had more of a story. Here is a sampling of the answers I received:

Danny Shields

When Mark Scharf and I went racing with the Bugeye Sprite, we called ourselves "SS Racing" and made Euro style "55" numbers that looked like "SS." We were kind of oblivious to any Chevy or Nazi connections to

"SS." I had made the cardboard template (right, no computer cutters back then!) so I used it to make "5"s for the Midget later, and other cars to follow. That is the number I ended up running in my first Nationals in 1983, and the Midget still has one of those "5"s on it today.

Actually, when I entered Nationals the following year, I asked for #1 as my first choice, #5 as my second choice. They gave me #5 even though there turned out to be no #1 entered. I settled on #5 after that. They run in numerical order, and I didn't want to be the first one out, but I wanted to run near the front. (By having a low number I bet I have led almost every Nationals I ever ran, at least for a few brief moments.) Sharron, of course, runs 51 because it is easy to coordinate with 5.

Maury Hamill

I've been using 60 since that was the number on our '85.5 944 Firehawk car. As you probably know, Firestone started the Firehawk showroom stock racing series to get back into racing after being out of it for many years. It was also to encourage more OE tire business from GM and Ford.

The first year 1985, a 944 won the series in spite of going against Camaros, Firebirds and Mustangs with twice the cylinders and displacement. Not the way Firestone planned it! So in '86 they reduced the size of the refueling hose for cars with over a certain size tank, read 944. That negated the fuel economy advantage of the Porsches.

Nevertheless, a friend, Keith Martin, who had maintained my Porsches for years, starting with the delivery of a '73 914 2.0 in Oct. of '72, suggested I get serious and go racing rather than just autocrossing. He offered to do all the prep and maintenance on the car for a share of the driving.

Most of the races were 6 hours, leaving 2 hours each for he, my son and I. Through a PCA friend who worked for the Holberts, I got Al's phone number. When I called to ask if

he knew of a showroom stock 944 that was available, he told me he normally dealt only with full race cars, but he did know of one at Brumos that had been driven in two SCCA Playboy races by Stirling Moss and Innes Ireland while they were waiting for a 944 turbo. A call to Bob Snodgrass confirmed that the car was available. Keith checked it out and drove it back to Virginia, stopping by an autocross to show me the car I had purchased.

In any case (way more than you wanted to know so far), Keith had been using 60 on his SCCA race cars for several years so we used that for the Firehawk races and I have used it most of time since. Surprisingly, in our first race, a 6-hour at Sebring, of 96 starters, we finished 6th, for whatever that is worth number wise.

Harry Chamness

I picked number 7 randomly at my first autocross and it was taken, so I asked if 07 was available. Again taken, then the next choice was 007 which no one ever picked and turns out no one ever picked it for DE, either, so it stuck.

After owning my Boxster for a while and making discreet modifications, I thought the number fit pretty well and decided I should keep it and made a request to keep it permanently.

Besides, I grew up watching all the James Bond movies and thought they were pretty cool - the cars, the women, the excitement.

Ryan Wise

It's not that entertaining, but 73 was the only number I could think of that was not that hard to do with blue tape. Now I've had magnetic numbers made.

Page Obenshain

My car numbers have been the number designation of the car - 986, 997, and 987. When I purchased a car, the numbers have never been taken.

Harvey J. Cummins

My number is 631. I wanted the same permanent numbers for autox and DEs. My favorite number has always been a 3. It was such a very long time, I can't remember why this was my favorite number. On second thought, it may have been my love for the Boy Scouts when I was a lot younger.

The problem in choosing a number was that all the DE permanent numbers with two digits were taken. I first asked Amy Gustafson, DE Registrar, if I could have #631. She said that was fine. And I was able to convince Sharron Shields, Autox Registrar, to also let me use #631. She agreed.

The theory behind my number is: #6 should be twice as much luck as #3; therefore, I should be #1 a lot of times and that's how I got to #631.

Brian West, Competition Chairman

The story of my autocross number all started back in the early 70s - when

I was born! April 8 (4/8) is my birth-day and 4 and 8 have always been my lucky numbers. Go to Jai-Alai? Bet the 4-8 quinella. You get the picture. So when I arrived at my first autocross a few years back, and Sharron asked me for a number, I requested 48. Nope, taken. Permanently. Hmm. Since I was just using blue tape to create the number on my doors anyway, something simple worked that day.

After a few events, my parents noticed my interest in autocross and bought me, for my birthday, a helmet and a beautiful set of magnetic number 48 signs! Wow, I was ready for the big time, but 48 was a problem. So I did what any nerdy engineer would do - I "fixed" the sign by cutting out the 4 and 8, and now I am always ready to compete with number 84.

I'll finish up by talking about my number. I'm #13. It's easy to make with blue tape. Don't think about stealing #13, because I've reserved it on our list of permanent autocross numbers. Yes, you can reserve a number.

Maybe my selection is a fist shake at the gods daring them to give me bad luck (possibly a spin out), but in a way it's really my defiance in the belief of having bad luck. I believe the adage, "Luck is what happens when preparation meets opportunity." – Seneca. So get yourself a number you like, and ... well, good luck to you.




