





The 911's home for the next 48 hours was the resort's indoor—and thankfully air conditioned—tennis facility, where we were quickly surrounded by spectacular Porsche history. The Concours Judging team was tossed a challenge when twelve inches of rain flooded the golf course venue the day before the event. Just as unbelievable, they were able to convert a covered parking ramp for over 300 cars, just in time.

Carol and I were surprised to win our Class against some very well-prepared cars and equally classy owners throwing us into the Group award competition against a wide variety of beautiful Porsches. Our second surprise was winning one of the three major overall awards for the Group Preparation trophy. An added bonus was that Carol got Wolfgang Porsche to sign the back of our Class Trophy. It must have been that smashing dress she was wearing that night. No way would he have signed it for me. Being a bit in shock, we then had to figure out how to fit the 30-pound traveling trophy into the 911 at 5:00 a.m. the next morning for the drive home. Okay, now we are retiring-really, Carol.







If you fit in either category, here's why you SHOULD sign up for a Drivers' Education (DE) event. Participants often say, "It's the most fun you can have with your clothes on!" I'm sure there are reasons you have not yet signed up for a DE event. Perhaps I can help dispel some of the myths and misconceptions floating around about DE.

It is NOT a racing school. Don't worry about coming in last or having a slow time. No one will know but you, and no one records lap times. You will be paired with a qualified instructor and you will be placed in a run-group with other first-time participants. You can relax and not worry about being run off the track by the faster and more seasoned drivers (aka "track junkies").

Your car is not modified. The vast majority of the cars participating in the event are stock from the factory. Porsches are track cars with lights and assorted other government-mandated items to make them safe and street

legal. These cars were meant to be driven fast and still remain reliable and safe. In fact, this leads me to the next point...

You don't want to "wear out" or "break" your car. Porsche developed and tested these vehicles with high performance in mind: the type of driving that is done at a normal DE. In fact, as a beginning driver, your tire-and-brake wear will be virtually negligible. Remember, this is not a 12 Hour race. You will take your car out for three or four sessions during the day that are limited to no longer than 30 minutes per session. Even in the Florida heat, your car will be fine. You are more likely to wear out before your car will!

You do not need to buy all sorts of gear for you and the car to participate. No need for a pro-driver's \$1,400 race suit. As for me, it's hot, and I'll be there in shorts and a t-shirt along with the other participants. All you must have is a helmet with the proper rating. If you don't have a helmet and are not sure you are ready to invest in one, give me a call, I may be able to help. Closed-toe shoes are also required. Cotton natural fiber clothing is the best choice.

You will dirty your beautiful car. You

will actually be driving the car on the track and you can't avoid the Sebring flying insect population. So, when you arrive home from your day at the track, you get the honor of washing your car. Think of this time as your opportunity to thank your car for the great weekend you had together.

You don't intend to ever become a famous race car driver, so why should you do a DE? My answer is simple. Your Porsche is a high-performance car. Learn how to utilize its performance in a safe manner in a controlled environment coached by someone with years of Porsche driving experience. You will learn car-control skills that can save you from a dangerous situation on the streets. Plus, it will give you the opportunity to enjoy the freedom of driving fast and not having to worry about speed traps.

Are you convinced to give it a try? I hope so. If you join us, you are sure to have an amazing time learning how to drive your car fast—safely. You will be surrounded by a welcoming group sharing your enthusiasm. When the event is over and you are driving home, you'll probably be thinking to yourself....Wow! That WAS the most fun I've had with my clothes on!

60th Porsche Parade Autocross

The Michelin Autocross at the 60th Porsche Parade provided two memorable days of Porsches being driven to the limit. Five Suncoast Region autocrossers took home first-place trophies.

The event took place at the picturesque French Lick Airport, which offered pleasant staff, air-conditioned restrooms, a long runway and a high-quality asphalt surface. National Autocross Committee Chairman Leeds Gulick designed a fun and roomy course. There were no really tight maneuvers, other than the 180-degree turnaround at the end. It was not as quick as it looked, though, and drivers found that it was easy to over-drive some sections and lose time. The finish was at the far end of the runway, nice and safe, with long taxiway back, allowing the drivers time to contemplate the run before receiving their time slips.

Video of the course was posted online prior to the event. We had watched the video repeatedly, and realized that you could easily go the wrong way at a couple of points. Most of the trickiness had to do with a short section that was used in both directions. Tire marks from cars going "out" tended to mislead drivers coming "back." We worked extra hard to learn the course. Several veteran drivers scored a "DNF" on at least one of their four allotted runs.

New Parade Competition Rules were in place, which included significant changes to the Production category. Tires must now carry a minimum 140 wear rating, meaning that DOT competition tires ("R Comps") are no longer allowed in the class, only in Improved and Modified categories. This was intended to make the "P" category more attractive to Porsche owners who want to drive their cars to Porsche Parade and not have to deal with bringing special autocross tires. Another rule change allows double-adjustable shock absorbers, which previously bumped a car into "Improved" category.

We ran our Boxster S in Showroom Stock on the new Bridgestone RE-71R tires. They have a 200-tread wear rating. The Boxster S thrived on the course, and Sharron and I won S03 Ladies and Men's classes. Bill Sumansky and Tori Lewis ran their similar car in Production, because their 17-inch RE-71Rs were not the exact original size up front. Both came home with first-place trophies. When the dust settled, the two, blue Boxster S's from Suncoast Region held the overall top times for the Showroom Stock and Production categories.

Bill Riley, driving his silver 40th Anniversary 911 coupe, emerged as the winner of P07 after another competitor was disqualified for using "R Compound" tires. Riley's car is really Stock, but he competed in Production so that he could play in the golf tournament on Wednesday and autocross on Thursday.

Maury Hamill ended up fourth in a large S04 class. His grandson, Zac Saubert, drove the Boxster to ninth place. Hamill's Boxster had represented 2013 in the historic "60-4-60" exhibit on Monday, while the Shields' Boxster S represented 2002.

The Parade Driving Trophy for overall Fast Time of Day (48.10 sec.) went to

Dave Montgomery, driving an awesome Modified-class 914-6, the same Greg Fordahl–built car that Leeds Gulick had driven to overall wins in the past. Ladies' overall top time went to Lynn Rothney-Kozlak, driving another Modified 914 with a 3.2L 911 engine. (Ed. Note. See QR code at end to view one of Dave's runs.)

Porsche family members attend nearly every Porsche Parade, checking in on the events and hanging out with avid fans of the Porsche brand. This year was no exception. Having competed in the first group on Wednesday, Sharron and I were recruited as ride-along instructors for the family and other Porsche VIPs. Sharron instructed Dr. Wolfgang Porsche, while I instructed his son, 19-year-old Felix, as they took to the course in a Racing Yellow Boxster S and a gray 991 Targa.

Felix Porsche claimed he had never driven before in an autocross or any kind of track event, but he showed impressive talent as he quickly learned the challenging course and put down some quick runs. Could driving ability be a genetic trait?

The start of the event had been delayed by the arrival of a sleek business jet. (Just because you reserve and close an airport, that doesn't really mean no one can fly in!) The entire course and related equipment had to be taken down in anticipation of the jet's arrival, and cars could not even be placed in the grid area until the jet parked.

On the second afternoon, the jet was scheduled to leave, but the clever Michelin folks kept the crew and passengers entertained at the Michelin Drive and Experience event, where they drove new Boxster GTSs, while our autocross wrapped up.

Early on the second day, a powerful storm system moving through the Midwest brought ominous clouds and a sudden, cold wind. The inflatable Michelin arch blew over and had to be packed up. Workers held on to portable canopies to keep them from flying away. But the rain skirted the airport, the wind calmed, and the sunshine returned in a few minutes.

Back at the host French Lick Resort, one TV channel featured Porsche and Parade videos, all the time. Films from early Parades showed 356s zipping around in a motel parking lot alongside buildings and spectators, nothing like the open airport space used for events now.





Almost all water-cooled Porsche sports cars suffer a design flaw or defect. Two of the coolant radiators are located low in the front fenders of the 996 and 997 cars (1999 to 2016). The Boxsters and Caymans have a similar location for radiators. These two intrafender radiators—inches above the road surface—have individual front fascia bumper air scoops channeling air to those radiators, which makes them very vulnerable to road debris. If a particular Porsche model has a front third-center radiator installed, its center air scoop fascia is more open, and it is equally as vulnerable as the two intrafender radiators.

Are the water-cooling radiators found on your Porsche model largely exposed? Our 2012 Porsche 997, Type 2 (997.2) radiators were exposed. We recognized very early on that our lower fender radiators were taking a pasting because of "flying" road debris and insects. In cleaning the radiators, besides insect parts and accumulated dirt, we vacuumed out stones, asphalt, leaves, wood fragments, and cigarette butts, all of which act in concert to block efficient engine cooling. The factory failure to protect these radiators is a serious omission and design flaw in our reckoning.

After some research on the Internet and the forums, we learned that there are aftermarket solutions that exist (1) to alleviate and help avoid radiator stone damage, and (2) to help prevent debris blockage to those coolant radiators. The fact that the solutions are, in our eyes, esthetically pleasing is another plus.

Besides do-it-yourself ("DIY") black screens, which are hand cut by the owner/installer from bulk wire netting and glued or screwed in, usually on the back side of the front bumper, there are two vendors that we found that are custom-molding or custom making wire mesh or stainless steel intake grilles for various Porsche models. One is Rennline, www.Rennline.com, located in the United States and the second is Zun-Sport, www.zunsport.com, located in the United Kingdom. Both feature their products on their individual Web sites and on YouTube.

After looking at the two Web sites and reading the forum comments concerning the two different products, we opted for the ZunSport stainless steel grilles in black, for our 997.2. (See, Photo No. 2, "Three Grilles in Shipping Plastic.") The selection can be a personal one, based on several factors. For instance, ZunSport's intake grilles mount in the outer surfaces of the bumper air scoops using an ingenious clip system, two metal snap clips on

either side of the three individual grilles (for the center and the two side scoops) that lodge/clip just behind the bumper's inside opening. From personal experience, those three grilles can be installed on the 997.2 (2009 to 2012) in 20 to 30 minutes.

The Rennline installation is a bit more complex as, in most instances, one must remove the bumper and then, using screws and clips, fasten the wire mesh grilles behind the bumper. Of course, if the bumper is off, and if your fender radiators are clogged with debris and dirt, it is easier, in that instance, to clean the radiators. However, the time to remove the front bumper fascia can be from 1.5 to 2.0 hours according to a number of DIY owners, and then it must be re-installed after one has installed the Rennline molded grilles. Also, if you like the look of the grilles behind the opening of the bumper intake scoops, the Rennline wire mesh grilles may be of greater appeal.

We liked the look of the ZunSport black stainless steel grilles with their very nice black surrounds on the outside of the intake openings. Also, the abbreviated installation time and effort with the ZunSport grilles was appealing. In our humble opinion, as fairly rabid concours people, ZunSport's grille design and manufacture is what the wizards at Zuffenhausen should have






Photo No. 2: Three Grilles in Shipping Plastic.

incorporated originally. However, just finding that there are several protection solutions to alleviate a problematic design flaw with our water-cooled Porsches is a step in the right direction for most of us. (See, Photo No. 3, "997.2 Center Grille, with a Plastic Tie to Position (Tie and Blue Tape Removed After Installation).")


Post Script. Since installing three sets of ZunSports on Porsche 997.2s, I have

installed one set on a 2005 997, Type 1 (997.1). (See, Photo No. 1, "997.1 Finished Grille Installation.")

The 997.1 grille set (2005 to 2008) consists of five grille pieces, two on each side, and one in the center. There are still clips, but the installer must drill six very small holes in the bumper fascia, one for the lower side grille for a holding screw, and four for the center grille, two of which are for holding

screws, and two of which are positioning holes for the grille wire itself. The installation time on the grilles for the 997.1 is about 2 hours, with the center grille taking the larger portion of the installation time. By taking your time, and re-measuring the locations for the holes, especially the two lower holes in the center fascia, you will be rewarded with an effective, and beautifully installed set of grilles for your Porsche 997.1.


