





# The cam sensor fault

I want to address a specific failure in the M96 engines that I've seen mis-diagnosed by independent shops— the mis-diagnosis of the cam sensor fault.

I have two cars in my shop right now. One has had a catastrophic failure because the car was driven after getting a cam sensor fault reading and replacing the cam sensor. Ordinarily, cam sensors rarely fail in Porsche cars. Cam sensor faults in generic scan tools are vague and misleading. Experience and the actual Porsche system tester paint a different picture. What happened to this car was that the cam chain broke and the valves and piston met catastrophically. Since the Cam was no longer turning, using the Porsche tester, the fault recorded by the DME (Digital Motor Electronics) was "Phase Sensor 1 Camshaft Halleffect sensor 1 exceeds limit value." It also records when the event happens (engine hours) and how often the fault occurred and at what RPM, coolant temp, speed, and when the last fault occurred. The scan tool only reads, "cam sensor fault."

On the early engines, there is a press fit "Reluctor ring"

on the cams to trip the sensor as the cam turns. I've seen these get loose and confuse the DME (engine computer) but not cause any damage, just loss of performance. The later engines had the "Reluctor" cast as part of the cam, solving that issue.

With this fault reading, the chain tensioner may actually be the problem and/or the timing chains can stretch beyond the tensioner's range. If this is the case, then the chain may fail and cause the valves to get too intimate with the pistons. This never ends well! Cam timing has to be checked if a cam's sensor fault has occurred. Generic scan tools can't do this, so the cam timing should be done manually—time consuming, but better than the alternative!

Basic scan tools only give information required by government regulations... not much better than using a "Divining Rod" to find water. Porsche testers have many more functions that go beyond just emissions-related failures. Most factory testers whether they are GM, Ford, BMW, etc. go further in depth than the Federally Mandated information available in the generic scan tools.

# FROM CTI THE Track Time!

There is good news in Florida when the summer is finally drawing to a close. No, it's not that cooler weather is ahead, it's the fact that now we get to have more TRACK TIME!

Our fall will kick off with the September 17th and 18th event at Sebring International Raceway. If you are a new PCA member, or new to our region, we hope you can join us for the event. I may be a little biased in saying this; but in my opinion, there's no better way to welcome you and your car to our region than spending it at the track learning new skills and meeting a fantastic group of fellow Porsche enthusiasts.

If you are a veteran member, we are also looking forward to seeing you back at the track and hearing about your summer adventures.

If you are a returning driver but did not attend our May event, you will see some of the changes we have implemented in an effort to improve efficiency and increase track time. We have also made some changes to the run group designations. The instructed levels (green and blue) are unchanged and the solo and instructor levels are now divided into 3 separate run groups. This will be explained in detail at the morning driver's meeting. These changes have lessened the disparity of speed on track and in turn created much less-congested run groups.

We have also changed our grid procedure that allows us to have more green flag on track time. Cars are now released up near pit out for their warm-up lap while the cars from the previous session are coming off track from their cool-down lap. The feedback from running the event this way was very positive after the May event. So come on out and see for yourself. If you don't have the opportunity to join us in September, our next event will be November 18, 19, and 20. This is our annual Instructor-training weekend. Friday and Saturday will be open to all solo- and instructor-level drivers. Sunday will be open to all drivers from novice to instructor. We will have a dinner at the track on Saturday night, so if you plan on attending Sunday only, please make plans to also join us for dinner at the track Saturday night. To all of you green and blue drivers, part of the enjoyment of our club is the camaraderie and we would love to see you all there for dinner. Watch the website and upcoming *Profile* for more information as the date approaches.

One last thing—there has been some confusion about helmets. PCA has now extended the deadline for the new helmet mandates. Any helmet with an SA2005 rating that remains in good condition will still be allowed until January 2017. The Snell Foundation recommends that helmets be replaced every five years. Suncoast PCA will allow the use of an SA2005 helmet along with SA2010 and SA2015 for the reminder of this year. In January 2017 we will only allow SA2010 and SA2015 helmets. We do not accept M-rated helmets for the DE events.

# Air Intake Screens for Porsche

Many Suncoast PCAers are familiar with ZunSport, an English manufacturer of stainless steel intake screens for European cars. Only too many Porsche owners have discovered that their front radiator intakes have, by design, been left wide open, leaving expensive radiators prone to stone damage and debris fouling. ZunSport intake screens were the first after-market accessories I mounted on my 987 Boxster after I found that driving around in the rainy Pacific Northwest resulted in an accumulation of a nasty, wet, brown paste comprised of cigarette butts, rotting leaves, and other highway detritus along the lower edge of the radiators. The ZunSport screens were very effective and gave the Boxster a smooth, rounded face reminiscent of the appearance of older, air-cooled Porsches.

So, after we decided in 2015 to add another Boxster to the family motor pool, I set out to locate some intake screens to protect our 981's radiators. I was very disappointed to find that neither Rennline, the maker of my Carrera's intake screens, nor ZunSport had anything on the market for the 981-series of Porsches. And then I burst into my happy dance...

On one of our recent rainy afternoons, while suffering from a serious bout of cabin fever, I found myself searching "Boxster 981 accessories" on, of all places, Amazon.com. I was very surprised to find, not only that Amazon now sells ZunSport intake screens as one of their North American distributors, but that ZunSport have finally brought their screens for the 981 series of cars to market. I immediately placed an order for the black, powder-coated front intake screens for our Boxster. Imagine my surprise when FedEx delivered my package within 48 hours of my "submit order" mouse-click. That's from England!-- 48 hours!

Installation, per ZunSport's excellent photo-illustrated instructions, took less than 15 minutes. The screens look as if they had been designed for the car by the geniuses in Zuffenhausen and blend perfectly into the front face of the Boxster.

I was so pleased with the quality and fit of these intake screens that I ordered their set of screens for the rear side air intakes for the Boxster, placing this order directly with ZunSport on their website www.zunsport.com. Same story: The order arrived two days later, and fit, finish, and ease of installation were excellent.

I am especially impressed with these products because not only are they easily and quickly installed without drilling or other bodywork modifications, but they can also easily be removed and reinstalled for easy clean-out of material that may have passed through the screens into the radiator area.





Because of its size, 7" x 5-3/4" you can fine-clean a car in much less time than with clay bars.






