For the benefit of those who have not attended an autocross sponsored by Martin Sports Car Club, you will have to face a very rigid technical inspection. Some of the items listed below should be well heeded:

Safety Belts will be mandatory
Tires will be inspected closely-any worn or unsafe
tires will disqualify you-HAVE GOOD RUBBER!
Safety Helmets are highly recommended but not mandatory. Your car should be in good mechanical repair
(a good appearing car-inside as well as out, will do you
credit)

Again I repeat - They Don't Fool Around on their technical inspections SO BE PREPARED.

ENTRY FEE to autocross will be: Council Members-\$2.50 - Guests - \$3.50

(We PCAers will meet at Wards Parking Lot, Dale Mabry & Interstate 4, Tampa, Florida at 7:00 o'clock May 22. We will depart at 7:30 sharp. For you who do not know how to get there, join us and we will direct you, or you may drive in our group with us.)
