914's, when you turn your key you hear a buzz that lasts about 3 seconds; that's your fuel pump pressurizing the system. If you don't hear this, and your engine turns over, catches at first, then doesn't start, your fuel pump is out. Before crying, check your aux. heater blower, (turn the key on and pull up on the heater lever) if it doesn't engage, fear not, for your fuel pump's and heater blower's relay's got power from another power relay and if all of the above occurs its the power relay that's blown.

Emergency replacement- Open engine hood, on wall, on driver's side is the electrical compartment, remove cover. Replace third relay (black pill box) with first. Hopefully the first relay is good and now you can drive to your Porsche dealer and buy another or two-(an extra). (note: these relays are used throughout the electrical system).

The only other recent development in racing and one I hate to mention is the death of Peter Revson while driving the UOP Shadow Formula I during practice for the South African Grand Prix. Revson was 35 and is the 10th fatal accident in Grand Prix racing in 6 years. The accident happened when he was coming out of a turn at more than 110 mph when his car left the road, went end over end and burst into flame.

It was only at Daytona for the IROC race where he finished 2nd and where I stood only a couple of feet from him as he explained to the news media how he had run the race. Racing is really going to miss him. He was the only American to be able to compete well in the Formula one circle. But he was a professional and really wanted it that way so he probably knew the risks well.

It's a shame he paid for this reputation with his life. Hope to see a few of you at Road Atlanta.

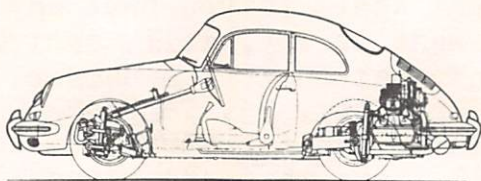
