Also, your officers are open to try about anything so if you have an idea (and are willing to do the work!) tell us and we'll see if we can get it rolling.

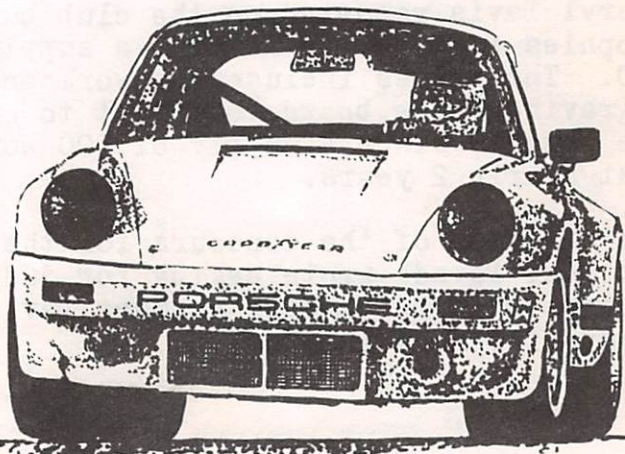

STRAIGHT AHEAD


As being the Co-editor of the Profile, each month I receive loads of information. Some of it goes straight to the round file next to my desk, some I read first and then it goes to the round file, some is retained in the Profile folders and some is very noteworthy and should be shared with the club members.

Two such items may be of interest to you.

1. The total PCA membership of 12/31/78 was 14,219. The largest region is Golden Gate with 655 members. The smallest region is Delaware with 17 members. Of the 108 total Regions our Suncoast Region ranks 46th highest with 174 members.
2. The Legislative Liasion Committee of the PCA reports that the chances of repealing the 55 MPH speed limit is about as good as Chuck Stoddard buying Firestone 500's for his Porsche.

On the positive side, the Committee reports Florida introduced S-38, which will require (after Sept 1979) any distributor of motor vehicles, who makes repairs to a motor vehicle prior to delivery to a dealer, to attach a statement to the vehicle's certificate of origin indicating the nature and extent of such repairs. (This will prevent guesswork about damage to your Porsche during shipping & transit).

Don't Jam Radars, Cops Told

The following is reprinted in part from a story in the Washington Star.

The Federal Communications Commission has warned the nation's police that if they try jamming motorists' radar detectors they'll be violating federal law.

The unusual warning to police-in effect, telling them they'd better obey federal laws while enforcing state and local ordinances-was issued after FCC officials became aware that some police departments were contemplating using a device to jam or confuse radar speed detectors.

The commission's three-paragraph notice notes that jamming or transmitting unnecessary signals are expressly prohibited" under its regulations. Further, selling or advertising transmitters approved by the FCC for uses other than those presented to the commission is a violation of the agency's rules.

It was quite a surprise since all drivers were turning strong times through the practice sessions preceeding the race.

Next in line with problems was the Roehrig 911 driven by GTU Champ, Dave White, John Hamilton and Curt Roehrig. The driver's and crew fought back in a valient effort as Lady Luck played one trump card after the other. They were never to see sun up Sunday. No fun or glory for the O1 gang this race.

The Sportomatic #36 red racer driven by Ron Case and Dave Pannacione was also parked before the sun rose Sunday. A lot of credit, but no glory, goes to Pannacione and the crew for building a new motor during the race.

The last of the Suncoast P cars in the heat was Charles Mendez's Busch sponsored twin puffer 935. After staying in the top #5 also became a course decoration 4 hours before the checker flag dropped. Charles teamed with John Rutherford and Paul Miller were comfortably in second place and carefully tracking the lead car when the hand of fate fell on our shoulder.

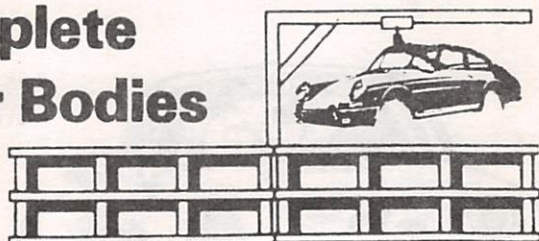

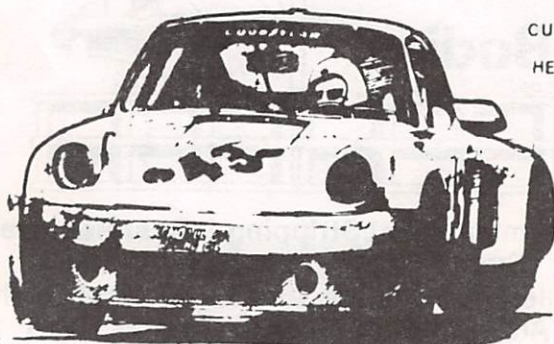

TECH TIPS

This is the last of a three part series on tires. It will discuss size designations of tires. Also a fitment chart covering most Porsches may be useful next time tires are needed.

This series is reprinted in part from the PIRELLI TECHNICAL DATA BOOK.

SIZE DESIGNATIONS OF TIRES FOR IMPORTED CARS

Dimensions are nominal

Radial Ply Construction

The letter R in the radial tire size markings signifies radial ply construction.

In accordance with European Standards a speed rating designation is required in the size marking. In the U.S. speed ratings are not relevant to the use of the tire.

— SR (R for radial) rated tires are designed for use on vehicles capable of speeds of 112 mph. SR rated snow tires are limited to a maximum speed of 100 mph.

— HR rated tires are for use on vehicles capable of speeds of 130 mph.

— VR rated tires are for use on vehicles capable of speeds over 130 mph.

Example:

Size 185 HR 14

185 — Section width in mm.

HR — speed rated up to 130 mph

14 — rim diameter in inches

This procedure also applies to 70, 60 or lower series tires with the addition of the series number in the size marking.

The series is determined by the ratio between the height and the width of the cross section of the tire.

Example:

Size 185/70 SR 13

185 — Section width in mm.

70 — 70 series — tire cross section height is 70% of its width

SR — Speed rated up to 112 mph

13 — rim diameter in inches

Size 205/55 VR 16

205 — Section width in mm.

55 — 55 series — tire cross section height is 55% of its width

VR — speed rated over 130 mph

16 — rim diameter in inches
