


It all happened a year ago at the Joiners great cookout party. I became a Suncoaster and little did I no what would lie ahead.


I suppose one day we may have to move along to another state and another Porsche Club but I don't think they will be as special as Suncoasters. Thanks for being such a great bunch.

Over the past three years our program has grown to serve hobbyists who, like yourself, know the value of vintage and special interest automobiles. From the start our goal has been to provide tailored credit for purchase and restoration to individuals with a wide variety of collecting interests. Generally speaking we offer financing for a maximum of sixty months, depending of the amount of the loan. Our current lending rate is 12% simple interest on any loan over \$3,000.00 with higher rates for loans under \$3,000.00.

We usually require a minimum downpayment of 20% on the selling or restoration price and we require that Maryland National Bank be listed as the lienholder on the title within 30 days after the proceeds of the loan are disbursed.

We use industry guides, written appraisels in some instances, and the knowledge of our own collector car personnel to verify the value of a particular car.

I have enclosed a few applications for the convenience of any of your members who might have an occasion to need our services.





TECH TIPS

Want to Change your 911/912 Windshield?

You're nuts, but begin with a sharp knife, about 10 feet of venetian blind cord, a can of silicone spray, and an unlimited vocabulary. Cut rubber molding perpendicular to the glass both inside and out. Remove the old glass, then pull the chrome out left to right. Lubricate the rubber and place the chrome on top of the rubber. Press it down into its groove. Put the cord in the remaining groove, with the ends on what will be the bottom. Lube both the rubber and the metal rim on the car over which the rubber hooks to hold the windshield in the car. Seat the assembly in the opening and pull the cord slowly out of the groove while pressing gently on the glass. The rubber will nicely hook over the rim (it won't perhaps, but the vocabulary helps). Wife and two sons are also useful in this, or an octopus. No one with sensitive ears should be per mitted around this operation.


