



# TECH TIPS

If you have a capacitive discharge electrical system on your Porsche, it is important to keep the points clean. As there is little voltage across the points, dirt and oil migrate on the point faces, and can act as a short. A good indication of this problem occuring is that the tachometer will be erratic and flucuate at idle. Solution: clean points with fine emory cloth, then run new, white bond paper between the points to finish the cleaning. Be sure to check the point gap; this is very important. Actually, do this first, it could be the entire problem.

Be careful not to get particles of the emory into the bottom-advance-part of the distributor out of the engine. The smaller the point gap, the less contact wear is experienced and Bosch allows gaps as low as .012" or .3mm.
