

At the Parade, I went to a National Board of Directors meeting.  
Some highlights;

1. National membership as of 6-30 was 14,888 with 106 regions and a growth rate of 82 more members per month (than don't renew)
2. Because of several inappropriate business practices, Group 5 will not be permitted to advertize in the Panorama.
3. The 1980 Parade will be held in Oregon between August 24 - 29.  
Competition enrollment will be 450 and social entrees at 400.
4. A National committee will be established to determine appropriate loss value in the event of theft or destruction.
5. As of 9-1-79 dues will increase to \$30.00 per year. However, the regional kick back will be \$9 instead of \$7 so we appear to be doing alright from the increase
6. Finally, the 1981 Parade has been awarded to Smokey Mountain Region - Parade will be in Asheville, N.C.!

Last months dinner meeting was held at the Carrollwood Country Club. A rather small crowd of 34 appeared. I'm not sure whether it was because the All-Star game was on that night or they heard that Huffman, Curts, Krekorian, and Stoops had 8000 slides of the Parade to show! 




