# BOARD MEETING

President Mark Krekorian called the meeting to order at 7:56 p.m. on April 1, 1980. Elaine Fitzpatrick was called upon for the Treasurer's Report. She stated presently our largest expense was the Profile. Some of the reasons being the ad payments have not been received and there have been some ad cancellations. Income from events was reported on and shown not to be making much money. Elaine requested event proceeds to be turned into her and after event expenses (e.g., trophies, etc.) be billed to the club. She can more accurately keep track of the treasury in this manner. Cheryl Owen was asked to report on the Malibu Grand Prix Autocross. She stated it was a good event but was a little disappointed in the turnout and the events income. She also reported that the Goodie Store was in good shape but needed more Pano binders. Phil Nolen was asked to report on the Cedar Key Caravan. He was extremely pleased with the event, especially the turnout of new members and old members who have not been to events before. Joe Pendergast reported on the by-law revisions. They were just mailed and he has not gotten any responses as of this date. In Emory Stansell's absence, the Profile was discussed by those present. It was suggested the phone numbers of the Board and Officer members be published and a monthly new member list be used as in the past. The Profile also needs articles (human interest, personal, Porsche, etc.). Elaine added we needed more ads to balance off expenses. An ad contest was suggested but not presently accepted. Many money-raising ideas were discussed but none adopted. Fran Huffman was appointed to head a committee to see if an additional regional membership fee would be feasible. This was proposed to be a \$10 annual fee as of January 1, 1981 called the "annual dues and subscription charge". This is to be reported on at the next Board Meeting. A discussion took place on the possibility of a regional charge to be added to the present charge for the initial club membership. This will also fall under Fran's committee. Gerry Curts, Wayne Timmerman and Brooke Ballagh reported on the Florida Porsche Autocross Series event. Brooke sent flyers to all regions concerned. He stated there will be 19 classes and not to over order trophies. He was going to order 75% of what they thought they might need and the rest of the trophies as they were needed after the event. The budget was discussed for the 12th and 13th events

and the overall events discussed in detail (see flyer). Course workers were decided upon as well as the use of five C.B. units. Rick Fitzpatrick reported on the Pig Roast stating all plans were complete and a good turnout was expected. Stu Rappaport and Patty Stoops reported on the upcoming Gymkhana including some changes that would be revealed in a flyer to be passed out at prior events to the Gymkhana. Riley's Rally was reported to be as indicated in the April Profile. Jim Owen reported on the safety rules. They will be published in a future Profile under a "Tech and Safety" heading. The 1980 Membership Contest was discussed and will appear in a future Profile. Elaine proposed a form to be used for upcoming events to project income and expenses. Joe Pendergast reported on Fireverksfest and gave cost projections. Mark adjourned the meeting at 11:19 p.m.

# F.P.A.S. RESULTS

## FLORIDA PORSCHE AUTOCROSS SERIES

The first event of the Florida Porsche Autocross Series was held the weekend of April 12-13 at MacDill Air Force Base. Event Chairmen Wayne Timmerman and Brook Ballagh did an outstanding job. The course was fast with the quickest line thru most of the corners deceptively disguised by careful pylon placement. Results of the event are printed elsewhere in this Profile. The FPAS overall points system has changed for this year's scoring. Each class winner will receive 100 points, the other finishers will get points based on their time in seconds relative to the winner's time in seconds as determined by the following formula:

$$\text{individual points scored} = 400 \frac{(1.25 \text{ winner's time} - \text{individual's time})}{\text{winner's time}}$$

This scoring system should make the yearend overall class competition much tighter.

# TECHNICAL

I have discovered in talking to some of the newer members that, after purchasing their first Porsche, they become interested in finding out more about the history and development of the marque.

There have been a number of books published about Porsche and I thought that a list of some of the better books on the subject would be of interest to those who have been seriously bitten by the bug.

## PORSCHE, EXCELLENCE WAS EXPECTED, Karl Ludvigsen Automobile Quarterly Publications

This is The book to have if you're only having one. Karl Ludvigsen is a highly-respected author of car books. He was given complete access to the factory files while writing this book. The book covers the complete history of Porsche from the first days at Gmünd through the development of the 928 and includes all of the production and racing cars. Although expensive, this is the single best source available on the history and development of the Porsche automobile.

## THE PORSCHE BOOK, Lothar Boschen and Jurgen Barth Arco Publishing Co.

This is a valuable book to have for at least two reasons, particularly for those interested in collecting or restoring the older cars. Firstly, the book provides interior and exterior photos of the various cars at the time they were produced. Secondly, it provides a complete listing of Serial Numbers and Engine Numbers. This enables a collector or restorer to determine the authenticity of a particular car.

## THE RACING PORSCHE, Paul Frere Arco Publishing Co.

This is an excellent book for those who are interested in the 900 series race cars. Paul Frere is a well-known and highly-respected journalist and race car driver. The book covers, in great detail, the development and history of the "Plastic Porsche" from the 906 to the 917-30. It tells of the development of each model and the changes made during its competitive life, gives the serial numbers of the cars that were raced by the factory, who drove which car in each race, race results, etc.



PORSCHE BROCHURES & SALES LITERATURE, Richard Merritt & Susan Miller  
Barnes Publishing Co.

This book reprints all of the known sales literature that the Company or its Dealers published from 1948 to 1965. This is primarily a book for those who are interested in the earlier cars or those who are interested in literature collecting.

PORSCHE, THE 4 CYLINDER, 4 CAM SPORTS AND RACING CARS, Jerry Sloniger  
Dean Batchelor Publications

As the title suggests, this book covers the 4 cam cars from the 550 Spyder through the Carrera 2000 GS and includes the Formula I and II cars. There are many interesting photos of the cars that established the Porsche reputation in automobile racing. The text discusses the development of the cars and some of their racing successes and failures.

PORSCHE TECHNICAL MANUAL, Henry Elfrink

This is an excellent source of information on maintaining and repairing the 356.

Now that you are all enthused about building your Porsche library and becoming a potential Tech Quiz trophy winner, you ask where can I obtain these wonderful books? 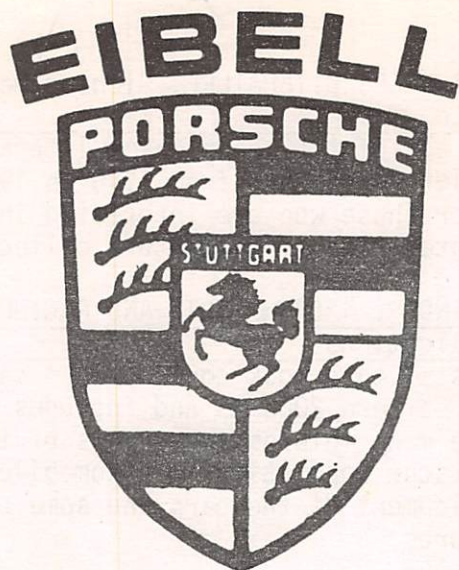

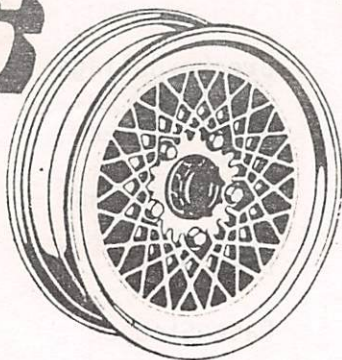

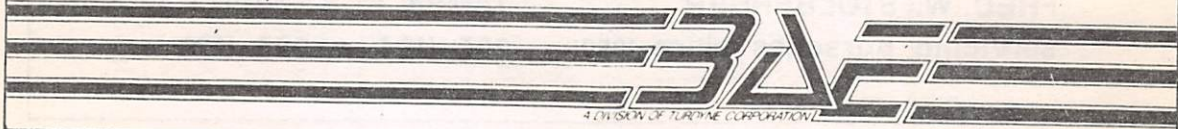
