BOARD MEETING

President, Mark Krekorian, called the Board Meeting to order at 8:07 p.m. July 1, 1980. Phil Nolen was called upon to report on the June Dinner Meeting. He was pleased with the turnout and facilities. Mark reported in Gerry Curts' absence on the two Tech Sessions. Everyone agreed they were teriffic successes and we should have more. Fran Huffman reported on the Membership Contests. They are not going well at all. There have only been three new members added from the contest. The membership itself has not increased because there have been as many drops as new members. The membership now stands at 221. Mark reported the next six months calendar of events is in the works with some firm plans and some still being worked out. Mark also reported that the August 11th deadline for picking the most enthusiastic family and enthusiastic member for National Awards should be decided on. The Profile was discussed and a decision was made that the editors should not over-edit articles that are submitted and better coverage should be given to submitted articles. Elaine Fitzpatrick was asked to give her Treasurer's Report. Presently, the treasury is in good shape because the expense of Fireverksfest has not hit the treasury. On a projected basis, we have a serious cash flow problem. Once Fireverksfest is paid for, our cash situation will be low. The reason for this being ads that have not been paid for and the high cost of the <u>Profile</u> publication. This problem will be rectified by a three-step procedure:

1) Appointed people to collect ad funds. 2) The <u>Profile</u> costs will be controlled by a \$200 per month budget including postage for the remainder of the year; this will necessitate the number of Profiles to be printed to be reduced and a reduction of the printing costs. 3) A fund raising Garage Rummage Sale to be put on by the Region. Joe Pendergast reported on the progress of Fireverksfest. The plans have been complete and everything is ready. Joe's only concern is turnout. At this date, registration is not as high as it should be which would leave us with only a possible breakeven financial picture. Seventy-five (75) entrants would make the event a worthwhile venture. The meeting was adjourned at 9:40 p.m.

TECH SESSION

Those of you who missed our June Tech Sessions missed a rare opportunity to learn about your Porsche and what makes it work. On June 14, Dave White of Sports Car Service spent half a day talking and answering questions about car preparation and driving technique for autocross competition. Much of the session was specifically about chassis and suspension dynamics, and Dave did an outstanding job of explaining "how things work" in a way that was easy for everyone to understand. Mark Krekorian taped this entire tech session and we are now looking into a way to get the most salient points typed up so everyone who wants a copy can get one. Quite frankly, Dave's talk was probably equal to anything at the War Bonnet Tech Session. We are lucky to have someone with Dave White's knowledge and expertise in our area and even more fortunate that he will share his experiences with us. Thank you, Dave White.

A week later, Reeves Import Motorcars opened up their entire body shop to Suncoast Region members for a morning of "hands-on" tech session. Jim Gold, Body Shop Manager, and his entire staff, were on hand to share their experience with us. We had several very informative demonstrations -- for example, they painted a car with the new German clear-coat metallic paint, showed us how to paint with a do-it-yourself spray can, rubbed out old paint and then used a glaze and fill product to produce a high gloss finish, repaired paint chips, installed new sunroof weather seals, repaired the headliner in a 911 Targa, sanded away paint drips, and many other similar things. In fact, there were so many things going on all morning it was impossible to see it all. Our special thanks to Allen Reeves and his dealership. We sincerely appreciate his support.




