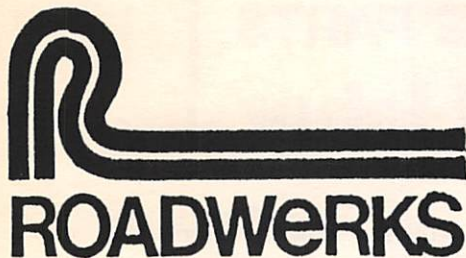
DINNER MEETING SEPT. 16TH.

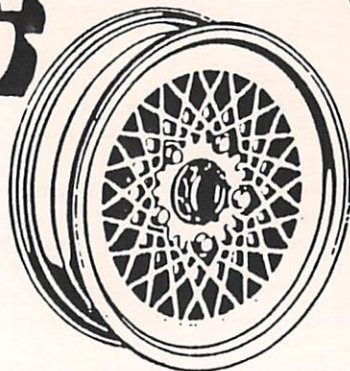

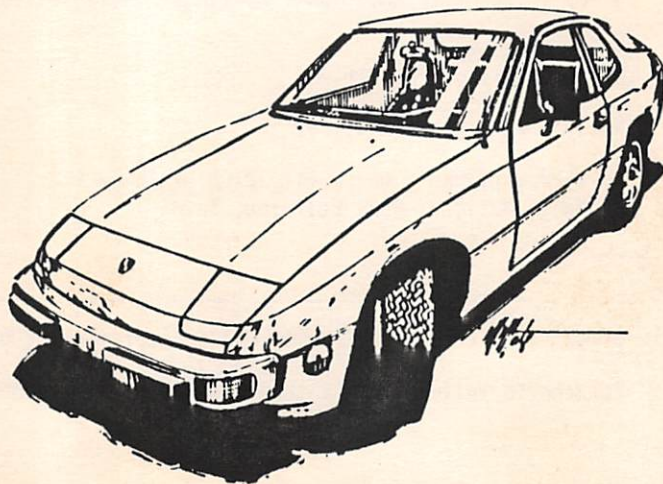
