I have been verbally assured that MacDill will be available in 1992, and I have already tentatively scheduled eight autocross dates including two Zone 12 Events and two Rookie Weekends (autocross schools). In addition to the usual eight driver's education dates at Sebring, I have also scheduled another Time Trial event on the old course at Sebring. Of significant note, there were three ladies that participated in the racing and sports times runs out of approximately 150 entrants, they were Andrea Tyler, Lindsey Hood and Sandy Woodworth, all Suncoasters! HSR will kick off a new season of racing starting with the Sebring Historic Races on the full 12 Hour Course on March 6, 7 and 8, 1992.

I have enjoyed the privilege of being your competitive chairman for 1991 and I sincerely hope you derived

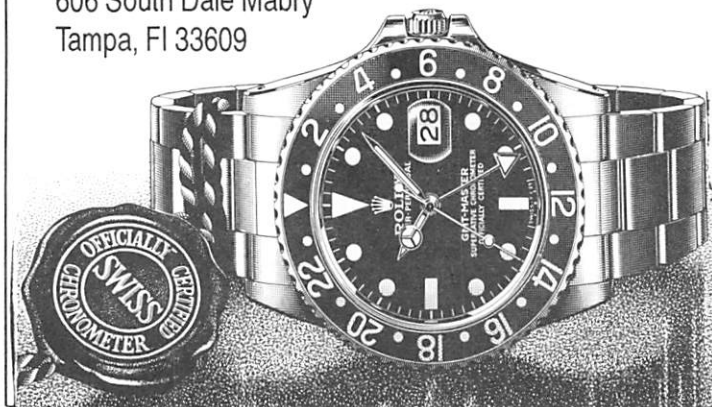

That's The Way It Was, November 1963

Ah...tis the season. We have come a whole year now. The "Profile" has made numerous changes and improvements in its short life. It has even gone to multi-color, with headings in red and all advertisers (8 now) in blue. It really looks rather nice for its humble beginnings.

This month we have a rally beginning in Largo, at the Midway Shopping Center, an autocross at the Crossroads Shopping Center in St. Pete, a benefit Gymkhana for P.A.L and a regular business meeting. What's this, no Christmas party?

The regular monthly meeting broke tradition this month, and moved from the East Bay Country Club to Sharpe Porsche & Cadillac dealership in Tampa. The new years slate of officers will be proposed at this meeting. President: Herb Trenka; Vice President: Bud Nelson vs Bill Basnaw; Secretary: Henry Deurer vs Hank Fahrlander and Treasurer: Pete Prout. As always, additional nominations will be accepted from the floor. After the business portion of the meeting was over and the new officers were voted in, everyone enjoyed a great discussion by Mr. Lint Coleman and Mr. Jack Atkinson on the "inside" story on what's to come from Porsche. The factory plans on introducing two new prototype 904 racing machines, using the newly developed 8 cylinder engine. Production 904's will be available with either the 4 cylinder 2 Liter, 200 H.P. version, the new 6 cylinder or (as the to be introduced) 8 cylinder. The body will be of fiber glass construction, with a tube frame construction weighing in at an unbelievable 1340 lbs. Of course you also get the 5 speed, all syncro transmission, newly improved radical suspension and the new disc brakes that were far superior to anything available at the time. I know this all sounds

"alright" to us, but wait till you hear the real news. This is going to make your stomach turn and grind. Porsche is accepting orders for the 2 liter - 4 cylinder version, FOB Stuttgart for a mere \$7,425 race ready. You could have bought 3 of them then and retired today. My, my, isn't hindsight 20-20. Closer to home, some of the new developments were mentioned for the 356C and the 356SC cars. The factory is working on "air conditioning and tinted windows". They must have spent the summer in Florida that year!! Also, the factory recommends that no multi-viscosity oils be used, and the oils used in Florida should be 40 weight in summer and 30 weight in winter.

Many thanks went out to Sharpe Porsche (& Cadillac) for providing the location, new cars to look at, the refreshments and the evenings speakers.

The P.A.L. benefit Gymkhana was carried over from last month, as it turned out to be a real disaster last month. Originally scheduled for November 10th, it was rained out by a #10 storm, so it was

rescheduled for November 24th, since the trophy's were all dated "Nov 1963".

Of course it did rain the morning of the 24th, but more tragic to the event was the assassination of President Kennedy. This of course, made for poor attendance at the event.

Here's a tongue twister for cold mornings: Stiff - Stick - Shift. Say that 3 times real fast.

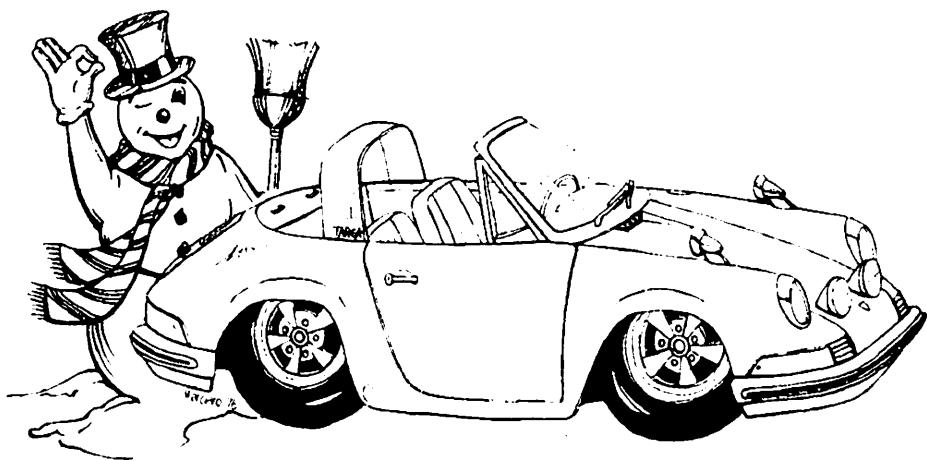
For Sale that month: 1961 Porsche coupe, 1600 Normal-like new. Owner going on Treffin to pick up a new car \$1,900.

To make things worse, Sandy Woodworth, with Andrea Tyler as her instructor, did an incredible spin right in front of me at the hairpin. I decided then and there that after this was over, I was going to divorce my husband and take up Ping-pong.

My turn was after lunch time. Apparently Lindsay Hood, my instructor for the day, heard that I was very nervous and came to give an encouraging talk. Finally my run group was called. Lindsay drove around the track a couple of laps, and then it was my turn to drive. Tentatively at first, and trying to figure out a weird gear box (which I later found out had worn out second gear synchros. Lorne Hunsberger, my second instructor would later teach me how to double clutch, thanks Lorne!). I tried to take in everything that Lindsay so

patiently was teaching me. By the time my sessions were over, and thanks to my instructor and the encouragement of other members, I was hooked.

After the Drivers Ed experience, we decided to try our luck in autocrossing, and I loved it. I gradually got a knack for it. I even went as far as beating my husband in his own car! Finally we tried a rally. I cannot say that we get along well during these, because our first time, and every other time afterwards, we got close to making an appearance in divorce court, but we always manage to finish in one piece and later laugh about it.

The time came for something the club calls "Werksfest", where some of these events take place during a weekend. We signed up and participated in everything. I got a very surprising second place in the Tech Quiz (always remember, when in doubt mark C). By the end of Werksfest, I realized that not only were we enjoying the events, but that we had made some really good friends too.

Since then, we have participated in as many events as possible. We've always had a wonderful time and look forward to future events.
