Porsches are such a great common bond.you might get the friendly jousting over models abilities but Porsche lovers, Porsche nuts, and Porsche addicts are always friends.

Well, almost always friends.

It was early in the spring of 1967. I had just finished my last assignment with the USSSMA (UNIT-ED STATES SUPER SECRET MISSION AGENCY) and was prepping for a little semi retirement before I set out to climb Mount Everest. While relaxing for a spell I decided to rent a little apartment in downtown PROGUE and buy a used 911 to hop around the countryside.
