Also, in July, we are putting together a Tech Day at the Suncoast Porsche in Sarasota. Tentatively July 13th or 14th. Watch the June profile for information.



Memorial Day Weekend, May 26-28, 2001 Admiral Lehigh Golf Resort, Lehigh Acres, Florida

On this coming Memorial Day weekend the heart and soul of Zone 12 can be found in Lehigh Acres, just East of Ft. Myers, Florida. It's ZONEFEST '01, and it's going to be GREAT. ZONEFEST is the multi-regional annual event in Florida and is jointly hosted by Goldcoast and Suncoast regions. Event headquarters will again be the Admiral Lehigh Golf Resort located in Lehigh Acres. Three days of Porsche madness. Come and partake in the fun, competition, and socializing with a group of people who share common interest and bond, our Porsches. Both regions extend a warm invitation to all PCA members to attend.

The weekend will start on Friday evening with a welcome party in the Registration / Hospitality / Goodie Store / Banquet Hall Suite where you can enjoy renewing old acquaintances or make new ones over snacks. soft drinks, beer, and wine. Saturday morning brings the Concours where cars are lined up on the lawn (photo op) and judged for cleanliness and condition. ZoneFest '01

GENERAL RULES

- 1. Only one car per person may be entered for points for the weekend.
- 2. Only one trophy per event per person.
- 3. Any person wanting to run a second car in the Autocross may do so for "time only", for an additional fee of \$25.00 per driver. However, he or she must make all of their runs in their trophy eligible car first.
- 4. Special fees are available for entry in single events as follows:

Concours and Rally - \$25.00 per car, includes eligibility for trophy. No food or door prizes.

Tech Quiz - \$5.00 per person, includes eligibility for trophy. No food or door prizes.

Autocross - \$40.00 per driver, includes eligibility for trophy. No food or door prizes.

- 5. Meal tickets may be purchased by single event entrants and as extra tickets for guests as per the prices shown on the registration form. Includes eligibility for door prizes but not grand door prizes.
- 6. Any entrant entered in the Concours and the Autocross must use that same car in both events.
- 7. A car other than the one entered for the weekend may be used in the Rally.

CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE

There will be 3 classes in the Concours this year: Full, Surface, and Mini-surface. The classes are as outlined below. Cars entering the "Full Class" (class 10) will be judged in all categories. Cars entering the "Surface Class" classes 1 through 9) will not have the underside judged and will receive zero (0) points for that category. Cars entering the "Minisurface Class" (class 11) will be judged only on the exterior and interior and will receive zero (0) points on the underside, engine and trunk compartments. If you intend to compete for the "Overall Weekend Award", it would be advisable to enter the Full or Surface Class because the total Concours points you receive will be used to figure the overall points for the weekend.

 - 1. All 356 Series.
 - 2. All 911 & 912 Series, 1965 to 1977.
 - 3. All 911 & 930 Series, 1978 to 1989.
 - 4. All 911, 930, 993 & 996 Series 1990 to present.
 - 5. All 914 Series.
 - 6. All 924, 944 & 928 Series to 1989.
 - 7. All 944, 968 & 928 Series 1990 to present.
 - 8. All Boxster Series.
 - 9. All current and retired Race Cars w/ log book.
 - 10. Full Concours Cars, (all years & series).
 - 11. Mini-surface Cars, (all years & series).
- 2. BONUS POINTS: (to be added to judging points).
- A. Mileage driven to the event One point for each 100 miles driven from the home region to ZoneFest to a maximum of 10 points. One-half point for each 100 miles towed from the home region to ZoneFest to a maximum of 5 points. No points will be allowed for cars trailered or shipped in any manner.
- B. Age of Car One point for each year of age based on the model year of the car, to a maximum of 10 points.
- C. Actual mileage on the odometer One point for each 10,000 miles to a maximum of 10 points.
 - D. No car will receive more than 10 total bonus points.

The Concours accounts for 100 possible points toward the overall ZoneFest scoring.

RALLY

This year's Rally will be a "time, speed, distance" type. This means you will be given a set of route instructions to follow at given average speeds (these speeds will be changed from time to time by the instructions). Unkno no second, you will come upon checkpoints as you follow the hally route. At each checkpoint you will be "timed in" and your elapsed time for that "Rally leg" (between checkpoints) will be later be calculated and compared against the "perfect time". For each 1/100 minut you were early or late from the perfect time, you will receive or penalty point. The penalty points for each leg are adde fin hing position is determined together and with the fewest points is the winrior.

There will be only one class for this years Rally - "Unequipped That means you may use rally tables, stop watches, pencil and paper; but no calculators or computers are allowed.

The Rally accounts for 100 possible points toward the overall ZoneFest scoring.

TECH QUIZ

The Tech Quiz will be held during the Concours judging on Saturday morning. There will be both a Men's and Women's class.

The Tech Quiz accounts for 25 possible points toward the overall ZoneFest scoring.

3. ALLOWABLE MODIFICATIONS

Modifications, unless specifically allowed herein will automatically place the car in class M1.

3.1 STOCK CLASSES

- 1. All stock cars with factory authorized options purchasable through authorized US factory dealers.
- 2. Any rim width without body modifications is allowed.
- 3. Any street tire with DOT approval number and speed rating is allowed provided no portion of the tire extends beyond the stock fender opening when viewed from the top perpendicular to the ground.
- 4. Air cleaners are free.
- 5. Re-jetting carburetors is allowed.
- 6. Sway bars are free.
- 7. Shock absorbers are free.
- 8. Suspension alignment and lowering are allowed provided no machining is required.
- Exhaust modification beyond the cylinder head exhaust flange is allowed.
- 10. Hydropneumatic suspension may be changed to torsion bar suspension.
- 11. Mild customizing and street-type spoilers are allowed provided the wheel/tire combination will fit under a equivalent stock bodied car.
- Cars may be updated or backdated within specification of their model range and series as provided in the current PCR's.

- 13. Brake rotors may be cross-drilled or slotted.
- 14. Any DME EPROM chip may be used except for those altering turbo boost.
- 15. Emission devices are free.
- 16. carburetor type is free on pre 1974 911's and all 914/4's. Fuel injection may be replaced with carburetors.
- 17. Any seat may be used. However, removal or substitution of any other item that might be considered lighting of the car is not allowed.
- 18. Simple street-type roll bars are allowed.

3.2 IMPROVED CLASSES:

- 1. Any modification allowed in STOCK CLASS.
- 2. Cars must be street legal and currently licensed, expect open exhaust is allowed when permitted.
- 3. Fender modification is allowed.
- 4. Gearing may be changed.
- 5. Brakes may be updated.
- 6. External engine changes are allowed.
- 7. Interiors may be removed.
- 8. Race tires are allowed.

3.3 MODIFIED CLASS:

Any Porsche manufactured cars not falling into the STOCK or IMPROVED classes.

3.4 GENERAL AUTOCROSS RULES:

- No retread tires are allowed.
- 2. Rubbing tires are not allowed.
- 3. A maximum of 2 drivers per car per class allowed.
- 4. Points runs must be made before "time only" runs.
- 5. Helmets are required. They show a Snell SA90 or M90 rated.
- 6. Seat belts are required and must be in safe condition.
- 7. An increase of up to 1.2 mm of engine over-bore is allowed in all classes.
- 8. All cars must pass the technical inspection before being allowed to compete in the Autocross.

The Autocross accounts for 100 possible points toward the overall ZoneFest scoring.






