

SUNCOAST BOARD MEETING AUGUST 3, 2001

President Ellen Riley called the meeting to order at 7pm. The minutes for July were approved as read. Ellen and Social Chairman Sharla Horne thanked George Mardjon, owner of the Car Collection for his hospitality and great food. George and his assistants really made Suncoast feel welcome. Chad Halllmark gave a final report on the golf tournament and it was a great success.

Treasury report was given by Bill Riley in place of Mark Krekorian. He reported that the Regions Treasury is solvent. Also, it costs \$2500 to \$3000 to publish the Profile each month. So please read it!







The "US Carrera 2.7 Registry"

OK its 1969 or something and I have driven my mom to the food store, at this age I will drive anywhere as long as I get to drive the car. So being the ever-good son I accompany Mom in, to push cart and help out. Up one isle down the next, nothing much happening here, finally last isle, Great, almost done and I have not seen any school buddies as of yet, avoiding major embarrassment, you know food store with mom, not cool. Almost in the clear and then it happens, there are no less than 12 checkout isles and Mom of course picks the one with the real cute teenage girl cashier. Cute sure, also this girl is my schools head cheerleader, voted most attractive, honor role, get the picture, well by the time I load our items on the counter the only thing keeping the cashier from adding my face to the checkout as a very large beef-steak tomato are the white eyes in the middle of all that red face.

Mom pays, we walk out to the car and Mom asks the question "who was that?" Brief biography on lady perfect and Mom comes back with the adult answer to every unfulfilled fantasy "Beauty is only skin deep" my thoughts and immediate response "What's wrong with that!"

Move ahead a few years, 10 maybe, I am picking up my new used Jaguar XKE, trading in my MGBGT, at a Porsche dealer. My good friend who works at the dealership is handling transaction for me when I see it. A 1974 US Carrera, gulf blue, its on the showroom floor, even though it's a used car by now. I stop conducting purchase of Jag, ask a few questions, and come to find out this 1974 used Carrera is exactly 3 times the price of my new used Jaguar. So it's not going to happen financially, as my friend realizes I am disappointed he utters those poetic words, "No big deal, Its beauty is only skin deep" again I get a chance to answer with out a thought "What's wrong with that"

You see what my Porsche learned friend was trying to tell me was that the 1974 and 1975 US Carreras were the same as the 911S of those years. But not really, visually distinctive, exclusive VIN numbers, limited production and just simply drop dead *beautiful*.

So now many years later I get my chance to buy a 1975 lime green Carrera coupe, gold wheels, gold lettering, then followed shortly thereafter by the addition of an orange 1974 Carrera coupe. Today I still own both, and have received certification from National PCA to represent a special interest group, The "US CARRERA 2.7 Registry". I try with the help of other members to find as many of the surviving 1353 coupes and targas from those two years of production. Exchanging owner information, help with restorations, sales of the cars, parts locating and anything else that would help an owner enjoy his or her special Porsche.

Some information about the cars. There were 774 1974s made, 528 coupes and 246 targas, all their VIN numbers start 91144xxxxx. In 1975 there were 569 cars made, 395 coupes and 174 targas all VINS starting with 91154xxxxx. There are differences and similarities between a Carrera and 911S beside the unique vin numbers. The engines are the same, as are the transmissions. In 1974 the 2.7 made 175 hp the 5 speed being the optional transmission or the even the rarer sportomatic. The Carrera has flared rear wheel wells, 6 and 7x15 alloys, first US Porsche production car with different size wheels, stabilizer bars front and rear, 20mm and 18mm respectfully, exterior trim anodized black, Carrera side lettering, and of course the famous rear spoiler, ducktails on most 74s with a few 74s getting the new whale tail.

In 1975 the Carrera and 911S differed again in certain areas. All 2.7 engines now produced 157 hp. due to emission requirements. The 5 speed was standard on the Carrera, option on 911S. Again wheels on Carrera were different sizes, now 7 and 8x15s, front and rear stabilizer bars, Carrera lettering and the now the unique whale tail.

Today the Registry has located some 400 cars, and is always searching for the remaining cars. Many of the cars have been restored, many have not, as with most pre-galvanized steel 911's rust is always a problem, also over the years many have had the original CIS replaced by Webbers or the original 2.7 replaced by a latter model engine. The market value on these cars varies greatly, I have seen unrestored cars with some rust going for under \$10,000, while a fully restored low mileage concourse car was advertised for \$30,000! Its' all in the eye of the beholder as to value.

If you happen to own one of these special cars or know someone who does please contact the Registry and keep the search alive only 900 or so cars to go!

We had over 30 members who came down to talk to Suncoast's two Porsche Technicians, Carlos Debonis and Frank Collins. Carlos and Frank put three cars up on racks and answered many questions that people had about their cars. We put a 996, a Boxster, and a 944 up on the racks so everyone could get a good look at some key components under the cars. I saw Carlos with his laptop diagnosing a man's 996 and Frank had about 6 people under the Boxster that was getting an alignment. My friend, Nick Hrycaj, had his 944 on the rack only to find he had a better front suspension than he thought. After some measuring he found that he had bigger sway bars than stock and adjustable Koni's. That made his day. From what I observed, Frank and Carlos were kept very busy by our members. I want to personally thank Carlos and Frank for doing such a great job for us. You guys are the best!

We all hung out until about 1:00 PM then made the trip down to Potters Park for a BBQ that was put on for us by Suncoast Porsche. At Potters Park we were joined by Members of the Corvette Club who also had a Tech Seminar at Suncoast Pontiac, also in Sarasota. We all joined together for some good food and conversation.

I have to give a special thanks to all that helped out to make this a very fun day for everyone- Chris Welty and John Archer did a great job manning the grill and cooked up some great chicken, burgers and hot dogs, Kevin Geyer ran the shuttle van for us, Phil Anderson opened the parts department for us and also took pictures for the Internet and Steve Van Essen for his help with the Corvette Tech Seminar.

Suncoast Porsche has been very good to the Club. They have been to all the Autocrosses this year with door prizes, food and drink. They show up at Sebring to help us out any way they can. The men mostly behind all of this are, Gordon McKeehan and Chris Welty. Thank you gentlemen. You have helped make this a very good year for our Club.
