# **Tech Tips**

#### **Lug Nuts**

John Mingst, Metro NY PCA

Lug nuts: Always torque your wheels to recommended specifications! This will keep you from over torquing the fragile alloy nuts. The last thing you ever want is to have a nut head separate from the flange portion. This can happen from a lug nut put on to tight, or removing them when hot. The other bonus to torquing the lug nuts is that you will prevent warping of the wheel on the hub. My advice for track use is to use the steel open head nuts for the track and save the alloys for the street.

#### Your Tires Old?

John Mingst, Metro NY PCA

How old are your tires? Many tires have a build code that is three digits following the DOT mark. Look for the this mark, it says "DOT" then three digits ex. "260" This means that this tire was manufactured during the 26th week of the year 2000. This is a great piece of knowledge when buying used tires, and the seller tells you that he just got them last year.

#### **Painting Brake Calipers**

Author Unknown

You can purchase the heat resistant paint from your local auto shop. The paint I use here is red engine enamel with ceramic with heat rating of 500F. You may also use paint for BBQ and over. You also need a fine paint brush, a cup or bowl, masking tape and car jack. Open the front trunk and take out the car jack from the spare tire.

Jack the car up at its designated point. Check your car's manual if you don't know where to put the jack. Raise the car high enough where the wheel barely touching the ground. This way you can relieve the tension from the weight of the car. Loosen all the lug nuts and remove them from the bottom up.

Once the wheel is removed, clean the brake caliper thoroughly. Mask out area that does not require painting with masking tape. Spray a little pool paint into a cup or bowl. Use a fine small paint brush and start painting away the first coat. Let the paint sit for half an hour and paint a second coat. Let the second coat sit for about 45 minutes. Now remove all masking tape. Put the wheel back on. Be careful not to hit the painted caliper with the wheel. Repeat the process for the rest of the calipers. Now let the car sit for 8 hours for the paint to cure. (that's what the paint can direction says) Have fun wheeling around with your bright brake calipers. End of Procedure.

#### **Tech Stop**

Now and then I get calls from members who are working on their cars, sometimes for the first time. Then they get to a point where they cannot remember how to put things back together. One of the most asked for questions is the procedures in doing an old change on earlier 911's is to not only drain the oil but to remove the plate and screen assembly to clean out as well. Herein lies the problem. The sump plate has an offset drain bolt will be partially blocked. (I am sure I do not need to explain what happens next). Looking from the rear of the car the bolt is on the left side pointing directly towards the left tire. This is a simple process but often overlooked during reassembly. Now, for my foolproof solution.

I have mentioned this to members many a time. The best thing you can do, before you take it apart, is to take a picture of the assembly with a digital camera, if you have the means. I often do this when working on my car. How many of you have disassembled drum brakes on a car only later to guess where the springs should go. Ah ha! Just what I thought! A picture gives you the chance to see what it looked like before you took it apart. Oh, and about those extra parts that you were left with when you put it back together.you get the picture. (No pun here.) I have a pail full of these that I have accumulated over the years. They seem to come from nowhere. If you do not have access to a camera or a repair manual, make a simple diagram of the part locations. This will certainly help you in the end.






