WHO'S READY TO GO KART RACING? April 15th

Since December 2005 one of the few kart racing schools in Florida has opened. In January 2006 I stopped down in Punta Gorda and met with Jean "Sebastian" Sauriol, the owner operator of International Motorsports Academy. I was very impressed with the program he was setting up. The Academy is a training ground for up and coming young drivers. I've been with him pretty much every weekend since. Having instructed at Sebring for the last 10 years, he hooked me up as an Instructor. Let me tell you what a joy it is to teach a young child how to drive his first race car. The Kid Karts for 4-8 year olds are 50cc racing machines. The next class up is for 8-12 year olds and their karts are 80cc. You would be amazed to see these young racers go at it. For us bigger kids, he has 125cc 85mph racing karts. They are called Tags, for touch and go (electric start and automatic trannys). Let's talk about exciting.... If you have never been in a kart at those speeds WOW is about all I can say. It is the most thrilling ride I have ever had. It takes a lot of skill and nerve to drive these cars. The track layout is a ½ mile 6 turn road course, with elevation changes, a corkscrew type turn and a 1000 foot straight that leads up to a banked oval. You can check out his program on the net at IMARACING.COM. or schedule personalized instruction by calling Sebastian at 941.726.1722. IMA also hosts group programs in their IMA SODI Kart Fleet You can check out his program.

Now, does anyone want to go racing??? I have set up a date for April 15th to do a 1 and a half hour Le Mans style Endurance Race for 30 (max) Porsche club members. We will run 10 of the IMA racing karts (6 ½ HP 45 mile an hour) with 3 drivers per team. At 1:00 p.m. you will get a practice run and then qualify for a grid position. Then the Enduro will start at 3:00 pm. Cost will be \$110 per driver. You can make up your own team or we can put together a team for you. If you have your own driving suit, helmet, neck brace, and gloves bring them. If you need a suit or any other gear, IMA has all you'll need on site.



Addiction

In April, 1973 I left Milford, Conn enroute to Jacksonville, Fla for a career job change driving a 1972 Audi 100. By May 1 it was obvious that the Audi needed A.C. to compete with the Florida heat and sunshine. I learned that the best place to get the A.C. was the Brumos Porsche Dealer on Atlantic Boulevard in Jacksonville. That's right: the famous Brumos Porsche Store owned at that time by Peter Gregg. Unaware at the time, I was exposed to the new and used Porsches embracing the Brumos Facility. Shortly after the Audi was enhanced with A.C. it was traded for a 1969 912.

As the symptoms of the addiction intensified increased power became mandatory. After enjoying the 912 for a year it was traded for a 1972 911T with the 2.4 eng and 140 HP. The T was a delight to own and drive and sadly after 3 years of pure enjoyment it exchanged too much paint with another vehicle and suffered an early demise with USAA writing a check in 1977 for the same amount paid for earlier. Something about exchange rates, inflation and the advent of the SCs in '78 with \$28,000. stickers.

A company car held the addiction at bay until 1984 when company cars were discontinued and I purchased a 1981 911 SC Euro with the 3 litre eng delivering slightly over 200 HP. compared to the U.S. cars with 180 HP. The SC was a tough, rugged performer. For reasons still not understood the SC was sold in '92 and replaced with a Lexus SC400. Every time I spotted a Porsche on the road, I realized that the addiction was overpowering.

Betty Ford did not offer a 28 day fix in some idyllic area in the desert. Driven by an uncontrollable psychosis I was forced to stop outside a boat dealer in Jan. 94 where an SC was displaying a for sale sign. What a coincidence; another Euro 81 SC with the whaletail rear spoiler in platinum metallic with berber tweed in beige. I had to have this Porsche! Hubert Kopff at German Motor in Safety Harbor inspected the car and advised that many mechanical issues needed attention. The young owner had earned a large commission on the sale of a boat and was anxious to buy a Vette so the car became mine at a reasonable price. From 94 to 96 I had the SC and the Lexus. In 96 I sold the Lexus and the SC was my daily driver until 2002 when I leased an 02 Jag X-Type [a Ford with a 3 litre V-6]. I now had 2 cars. The SC had been painted, received a top half rebuild [pistons and cylinders] and numerous other repairs and enhancements [chain tensioners and unsuccessful attempts to have AC that actually did work]. The epitome of pure pleasure derived from the SC occurred in April, 1998 when I participated in driver training at Sebring. Talk about putting the pedal to the metal. Until you have driven at full speed at Sebring you have not driven your Porsche. A cosmetic note: This platinum metallic SC was adorned with burgundy lettering on the lower panels on each side: " PORSCHE".

With senior status rapidly encroaching it was time to evaluate my relationship with cars and concluded the following priorities: 1. Wanted one car. 2. Had to have a Porsche with current amenities [read AC]. On Mar. 9th, '05 my beloved and faithful was sold to a lady whose husband had an old 914 in the garage that was a project in progress. Worthy of mention are some numbers. The car was purchased for \$10K in 94 and sold for \$12K in '05. During the 11 years I spent \$22k [\$2,500.00 for paint and \$3,500.00 for engine]. It cost \$2k a year to drive a Porsche that provided a plethora of pleasures and just plain fun. As the addiction prevailed I could be spotted at Bert Smith " just looking ". The Cayman was not available yet and guess what? There I was just looking at the '05 997. There just happened to be a silver Carrera with 6 speed stick shift and 19 inch wheels. A deal was struck. Bert Smith took The Jag. and paid the last 4 lease payments and fixed a dent. What a journey! Thirty years to complete. With the 3.6 engine producing 325 HP, driving this fabulous 911 is a dream come true. This 911 enjoys a unique feature that the salesman called AIR CONDITIONING. At the risk of committing plaigerism it should be noted that a substitute does not exist.

Finally, if your Porsche is not a 911, well, it is not a 911.


Because apples don't fall far from the tree, my daughter drives a silver '06 Cayman and my son a 1991 944S2 Cabriolet.


I thought about that day for several hours when I arrived home and realized how blessed Steve and I are. We had such a wonderful childhood; and now we have an outstanding adulthood.

I hope you have a wonderful 2007 and mark "RICH HOUSE" somewhere on your social calendar for December 2007.


