



Secretary Report - Janie Gaglione - March minutes were approved by email.

Treasury Report - Charlie Neilson - Charlie emailed the treasury report to be reviewed by the board members. The check for the Ronald McDonald house has been sent to Page.

Drivers Education - Amy Gustafson - emailed that we have 30 entrants in the blue group, 26 entrants in the green group and about 12 entrants in the yellow run group. Come to the Rookie Autocross - test your Porsche's limits without breaking the bank!

Its fun for all types of cars from the daily driver to the full-blown racecar!

All Porsche club members are invited to attend a rookie autocross on May 6th at Zephyrhills Airport. (Directions are on the web site.)

This event will start promptly at eight o'clock. What is an autocross you might ask? An autocross is a performance-driving event that pits car and driver against the clock; it's just you and the course. The actual courses are set up with cones much like something that you would see on Car and Driver skid pad tests. Your runs will be timed to show your progress.

This event is going to cater to rookies; however, seasoned veterans are welcome to come out, drive, and instruct. In the morning we will split the course up into sections and instructors will show you how to approach each maneuver. I don't like to drop names but, Danny Shields and his wife Sharon with 12 SCCA national titles between them, will both be instructors. After every one has learned the individual maneuvers we will link the sections together to form the autocross course. All drivers must have a valid Drivers license, and persons under the age of eighteen must have parents sign a release form at the event.

Helmets are worn on the course for safety. The helmets must be snell 2000 or newer. We have no loaners so if you don't have a helmet we will find someone to share with you. Your car needs a little attention also make sure that your tires are inflated to the proper pressure and be sure they have enough tread. Wear clothes and shoes that you can drive in- no sandals or flip-flops please.

I really hope to see you all there.




Our Region each year puts on a great weekend package, starting with the drawing for the Indy ride.





PORSCHE ON PARADE

2007 PORSCHE RS SPYDERS COMPLETE 12 HOURS OF SEBRING WITH ONE LMP2 PODIUM FINISH: NEW 911 GT3 RSR (TYPE 997) FINISH-**ES SECOND AND THIRD IN GT2 CLASS**

SEBRING, Fla. - March 17 - Porsche Motorsport customers debuted two new race cars - the 2007 Porsche RS Spyder and the 2007 Porsche 911 GT3 RSR (type 997) - at the 55th Annual Mobil 1 Twelve Hours of Sebring, and competitors responded by finishing on the podium in both classes.

Finishing third in the LMP2 class despite encountering a series of electrical problems, the #7 Porsche RS Spyder prepared by Penske Motorsports, was driven by Timo Bernhard/ Romain Dumas/Helio Castroneves. Fifth in class was the #16 Dyson Racing Porsche of Andy Wallace/Butch Leitzinger/Andy Lally. It was second overall during the early part of the race before an accident with an LMP1 entrant, and subsequent transmission issues and electrical problems dropped them back. The #20 Dyson Racing Porsche RS Spyder, with Chris Dyson and Guy Smith aboard, lost 24 laps early in the race due to contact with a GT2 car, and later dealt with a leaky power steering rack, resulting in a seventh-place class finish.

Finally, #6 Porsche RS Spyder prepared by Penske Motorsports, with Sascha Maassen/Ryan Briscoe/Emmanuel Collard, spent 13 laps in the pits with a broken brake line in the first hour, and then encountered various electrical problems including a failed alternator which cost the team more than 90 minutes in the garage for repairs. The final results showed an eighth place finish in LMP2 for the #6 entrant.

In GT2, the battle for first place was between the #45 Flying Lizard Porsche 911 GT3 RSR of Jorg Bergmeister/Johannes van Overbeek/Marc Lieb and the #62 Ferrari 430 of Melo/ Salo/Mowlem - with the two-car tussle going for more than seven hours. In the last hour, however, in an effort to repass the Ferrari, the Lizards pitted to get fresh tires, but the gap created by the pit stop looked like it would be too much to overcome. It was Jorg Bergmeister versus Jamie Melo for the last 30 minutes, with Bergmeister closing the gap to less than one second on the last lap. The cars swapped positions on the last lap, but Melo managed to edge Bergmeister by two-tenths of a second to win the class.

The #71 Wolf Henzler/Robin Liddell/Patrick Long Tafel Racing Porsche 911 GT3 RSR finished third in class, a podium finish for Tafel in their first-ever American Le Mans Series event. Fourth was the Farnbacher-Loles Porsche 911 GT3 RSR of Pierre Ehret/ Dirk Werner/Lars Erik Nielsen.

Drivers Ed First 2007 Event Reminders

As we approach our first event for 2007, on May 12, I wanted to take this opportunity to provide a few DE reminders that will make your participation a totally enjoyable experience.

Please note all groups: There has been a revision to the DE vehicle equipment requirements for 2007. As in the past, if your car has a race seat and harness installed there must be an equal seat type and harness for your instructor. In addition now, that seat must be a designed race seat with provisions for 4-5-6 point harness to pass through openings in seat. No longer can you use a Porsche standard street seat with a harness that goes over seat back to fasten to seatbelt lock points. As in the past a stock seat with stock belts is still acceptable for DE, but if you install a race seat remember the rules, this is something that will be checked at tech.

Green group drivers: Be sure to read over DE participation items listed on our website www.pca.org/sfl this will take some of the unknown out of your participation. If you are a first time attendee, RELAX, you will have the time of your driving life.

Blue group drivers: Congratulations on moving up to the advanced instructed group. You have shown the knowledge and skills necessary to receive advanced instructing on the safest and quickest way around Sebring in your model of car. Keep in mind the instructor in your car is placing a lot of confidence in you for his or her safety and will be gauging your ability to continue to learn the skills necessary to progress to solo.






