


Philanthropic Activities







Highlights of the Service/Tech Clinic Held July 21 at Suncoast Porsche



Getting Ready for a DE Isn't Hard with Some Planning: **Here are Some Tips**

Download forms from Suncoast PCA website; tech form, med form, check list. Get your car checked out two weeks prior to the event to have time to address anything it might need. The maintenance book in your glove box was written by lawyers and accountants as a minimum guide for normal street driving. Be prepared to maintain your car at a higher level for safe and reliable performance on the track. Brake fluid needs to be flushed at least once a year and more often if you are in the yellow or red run groups! Brake pads must have at least 50% of the pad remaining. Brake pads run hotter and wear much faster when the there is less than 50% of the lining left. Oil level on Porsches should be at mid level (between arrows on stick or display). The level on other makes should be just under full. Fresh oil change is best, however oil with 1,000 - 2,000 miles is okay. You might go past that depending on how hard you drive the car. Consider an early oil change as cheap insurance.

Tires should be at least 30 psi and tread more than 4/32nds for street tires. Seat belts and retractors need to be in good condition. You need to be able to cinch up your belts. Wheel lock bolts should be replaced with standard wheel bolts.

If you have race seats there must be equal seating and restraints on both sides if you are in the green or blue instructed groups. See the PCA website under "Drivers Ed" for complete description of seat and restraint requirements.

DAY OF EVENT

Be ready when you get to the tech line and have anything that is not bolted to the car removed! Floor mats, empty the door pockets, lock glove box, check under seats for anything that could find its way to your feet! You'd be amazed what finds its way under the seats. Have your valve caps removed! Have your helmet out of the bag and ready to be checked, have tech sheet and med form filled out, have front and rear lids unlatched and the fuel door on air-cooled cars released. All this will make the tech line go much quicker!

After your car is teched, it is greatly appreciated if you would come back to help tech others so we can rotate volunteers out. Besides, we have a lot of cool toys come through the line and it's a lot of fun!

Instructors should be ready to tech each others cars as there will be a designated line for instructors. You will tech the instructor's car ahead of you in line.

The idea was to find everything just big enough to fit in this little car which was a challenge on its own. I used every possible space I could find. I even used the space found where the rear seats folded down. I did a little test weeks before to see how it would all fit. The odometer on my 1984 911 read 192,500 before leaving. My concern was will it make the trip. I decided to take it to Eibell Performance for a once over check. I am glad I did., but my checking account was a bit lighter afterwards. Its good to know what shape the car is in. The biggest expense was the AC compressor, among other things. I know the AC in these cars is less than desirable, but its so small inside that it cooled just a bit to make it worth while. The car stayed there the better part of a week.


July 1st was coming up soon. I gassed her up, and turned the trip odometer to zero, only to realize later, when we had left, that the odometer was not working, a big disappointment.

Margaret kept an accurate log on mileage, stops, and for how long, and distances between the stops as per the map available. We took many pictures with our digital camera. Movies were taken when we drove Hwy I in California and other twisty roads. We arrived in San Diego Tuesday early afternoon. What a trip !!!! The first day we covered about 1075 miles, stopping overnight in Katy, Tx about 35 miles west of Houston. The next day, 6 am, with some rain, we departed. We stopped in San Antonio, to show Margaret the river walk area. I had lived in San Diego in the past. Then, a bit later, the Texas Interstate became a very straight road. Very little vegetation was present the longer we drove west. The heat was almost unbearable. Thanks to the little car's AC, we did just FINE.

We stopped for the night in a hole in the wall place just over the border in Arizona. The motel was similar to the town. Who cared, we where leaving very early Tuesday am. I remember we gassed in El Paso and the next thing I know we are filling up in Yuma, Arizona. I watched the gallons total to be 21.333. I believe 1984 Carrera holds 21.7 gal. WOW, that was close. !!! It also turned out to be 26.10 miles / gallon 557 miles. I never did it again. !!


The last few miles to San Diego where some of the most straining. We had to climb very high to descend into San Diego. A few cars were seen on the side with overheated problems.
