Our First PCA Event, Our First Porsche

In 1997, I was selling Porsches for Bert Smith International, but not yet a PCA member. My sales manager asked me to represent the dealership at the PCA Zonefest Event and sent us to Sebring in a 993 C4S right off the showroom floor. My boyfriend (not yet husband), Grant, and I had no idea what to expect. We had a blast! Our experience with the friendly Porsche club members, and the thrill of our first autocross, made us want to come back for more. As we drove home, we were already working on a plan to purchase our first Porsche of our own and become members of the club.

A week later we spent a beautiful day on the water with friends and their new boat. Our friends owned a towing company at the time so we took the boat to the tow yard for a wash when the day was done. While the guys unhooked the boat, I was looking at the wrecked cars in the yard, and spotted an old yellow Porsche 911 off by itself. It wasn't wrecked, but covered with a thick layer of dirt and had weeds growing up through the empty engine compartment. I called Grant over for a look, but he was not impressed. Our friend said the car wasn't theirs, but he thought it had something to do with the automotive repair shop next door.

The next day, Grant contacted the repair shop to find out what was up with the old yellow Porsche that looked abandoned in his back lot. The Porsche's owner had hired the shop to restore the car, but wasn't paying his bills. So the repair shop had filed a lien on the title. The car was ours if we satisfied the two-year-old bill of \$2,000. We didn't think twice about it, the car would be ours without knowing the year, model or if it had a motor.

Our first Porsche arrived in the driveway June 1997, and the car was in much better shape than we first thought. We received an engine block, five boxes of unmarked parts, all the interior components, and the title to a 1966 912 Coupe, which allowed us to become PCA members.

Fast forward through Zonefest 1998 and 1999, our move from Dunedin to Gainesville, our wedding, and our move back to Dunedin. After our return home, Grant made an attempt to start rebuilding the motor (in our kitchen), but realized it was more precise than the VW motors he previously rebuilt. We wanted a pro to get everything out of it he could.

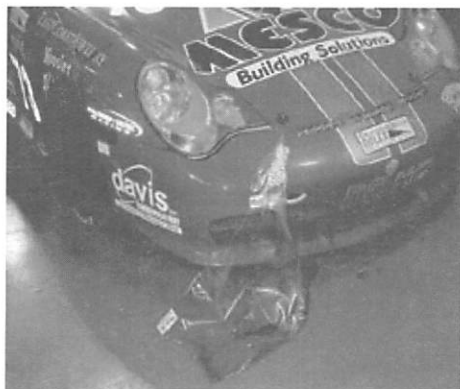
I knew the owner of German Specialties, as he had been one of the Porsche Certified Master Mechanics I worked with at Bert Smith. I walked into his shop with a crankshaft in my hand and asked Leo if he would build a car around it. He discovered the engine needed new pistons and jugs, among a long list of little things. The fuel tank was full of old gas that had turned into toxic goo. So the 912's first drive was with a plastic gas tank duct taped to the rear window with a tube running down to the fuel pump. She ran great! Over time, we tracked down all the little parts needed to make the car street legal. I think we have about \$5,000 into it now. Not bad for such a fun car!

The next year, we drove the 912 to Daytona to watch the 24-hour race. It was COLD and we had no heat, but had a great time. The short wheelbase car is so raw to drive! No radio, no anti-lock brakes, no air conditioning, no traction control, no shoulder belts, no problem!

We have since added two other Porsches to our stable, both with stories of their own. I wonder what Porsche we'll adopt next?
