




The President's Message



We had a lot of fun visiting with over 60 of our friends at the Open House. I heard the BBQ was good and the weather held back so it was a nice day without rain.





My Third Porsche

What about the first two? I bought my first Porsche, a 1982 911 Targa in 1990 after finishing graduate school. I figuered I'd pay off the student loans later. Three years and a small inheritance later I upgraded to a 1989 930. I really enjoyed the Turbo except for the heat. A black-on-black Turbo Coupe just couldn't be cooled in Florida. Four years and two kids later, I sold it for the downpayment on my house. I guess we all have to grow up sometime!

I went Porscheless for the next four years. Then one day my wife suggested that I buy another Porsche. Boy is she nice! After much deliberation, I chose a blue 1972 911 T. We have even attended a few DE's together. But that's another story.

Rennsport Reunion III

Porsche fans from around the world converged on Daytona International Speedway November 2-4 for Rennsport Reunion III, a celebration of Porsche's racing heritage. Organized by Porsche Cars North America, the event offered a memorable experience for thousands of PCA members and Porsche enthusiasts. The Concours d' Elegance and racing featured more than 20 examples of the fabled 917 and even more of the enormously successful 956/962 series cars. A general admission pass offered full access to the garage area, where enthusiasts could meet the racing legends and steep in the Porsche aura.

Our club had been asked by PCNA to handle several Rennsport activities. Suncoast members and PCA members from other Florida regions held key roles. Jennifer Barrows, of Florida Citrus Region, and myself shared overall responsibilities for the PCA activities.

The PCA "History of Porsche Cars" display, chaired by Suncoast Region's Steve Gaglione, featured 52 superb examples of the Porsche production models. Beginning with a Dennis Frick's exquisite 356 Continental 1500N Coupe from 1955, the same year PCA was formed, the collection proceeded through five decades of Porsche history to Gerry Curts' stunning new GT3 RS.

Visitors expressed a sense of history and wonderment as they studied the rare, preserved cars. Each car owner was awarded a stylized 911 pewter memento and a certificate signed by PCA President Prescott Kelly and motorsports legend Brian Redman.

Six of the 50 existing Carrera Club Coupes were displayed in a special exhibit. Comments were heard from guests who had read about this special model but had never seen one. One little girl who had seen the movie "Cars" exclaimed, "Look! 'Sally' cars!" Gerry Curts assembled this largest gathering of Club Coupes, and Porsche AG helped by contacting the owners and bringing Club Coupe #1 from the museum.

Approximately 300 Porsche drivers enjoyed Friday's PCA touring laps, generating about \$6,000 for the Camp Boggy Creek charity. Mark Peebles, of Florida Citrus Region, organized as many as 100 cars per session and got them on-track right on cue. It is quite a sight when 100 Porsches take to the Speedway at once, even for touring laps! You can imagine the spectacle later, when the green flag flew above the largest group of 72 vintage racers, ranging from 914s through 904s, 356s, 550s and even an Elva-Porsche!

Over 600 Porsches were on display in the PCA model-specific parking corrals on Saturday, the busiest day. Tom Gorsuch, of Space Coast Region, and his team worked long and hard to keep them organized, creating a huge Porsche display running the length of the boardwalk along Lake Lloyd, in the Speedway infield.

Doug and Sara Monaco, of Suncoast region, set up a booth offering new PCA apparel items for sale to PCA members. Sales appeared to be brisk.

PCA's hospitality building attracted visitors from around the globe, including the president of a 356 club from Germany, the past president of a Swedish Porsche club, about 20 members

of a French Porsche club, and at least twelve members of a Porsche club from Great Britain. Mike and Diana Hansen, of Gold Coast Region, created a great place for folks to get away from the sun and noise, and enjoy some camaraderie with PCA friends.

PCA Hospitality volunteers distributed a variety of literature including maps, schedules, Porsche Panorama magazine, "The Porsche Family Tree" booklet, and the PCNA Owner Relations VIN cards. The supply of PCA applications was exhausted.

"Tech talk" sessions were held each day in Hospitality at 9 a.m. with members of the PCA Technical Committee. Owners could ask questions of the committee members and then go outside to the car corrals for hands-on discussion.

The PCA banquet had sold out on the first day that registration was open. It was unfortunate that no more people could be accommodated, in the largest banquet facility available, and many of our PCA friends were disappointed at not getting tickets. (Porsche Parade over-subscription procedures were followed.) The lucky ones who did get tickets were treated to good-natured banter from the speakers, German Jurgen Barth, Frenchman Gerard Larrousse, and Belgian Willi Kauhsen, all of whom drove the featured cars to victory in international races.

Vu Nguyen of the PCA staff prepared a great slide show of Rennsport scenes, which ran continuously. Bob Herrman of Florida Citrus Region and Suncoast Region's Gordon McKeehan planned the dinner, with ticket arrangements handled by the PCA national office.

A total of 176 PCA volunteers, including alternates, were signed up to support the various Rennsport activities. Bob and Dora Barren of Florida Crown Region did an incredible job of keeping them organized and making sure all spots were covered and everyone had their "Volunteer" shirts, which were given by PCNA. Roger and Sherry Fabel of Gold Coast Region provided invaluable support, putting the worker lists into an Excel file that was used to manage the assignments.


Three PCA national scrutineers led by Dick Dobson performed the inspections of the race cars to ensure their on-track safety. How often are they called upon to check out a 917? Many of the cars had never been in this country before, including a special 16-cylinder 917 roadster. According to Brian Redman, four cars from Europe were held up in Customs, and only arrived on Saturday. It seems they have to X-ray imported vintage racing cars these days.


Both Reeves Import Motorcars and Suncoast Porsche provided great support for the PCA activities. The team from Suncoast Porsche drove around the infield in their black "TransSiberia" style Cayenne S, handing out water bottles to our PCA volunteers, and to appreciative track workers. Porsche of Melbourne had offered to provide a pace car for the touring laps, but that role was eventually bestowed upon professional drivers in PCNA press cars.

All attendees had a chance to drive new Caymans and Boxsters on an autocross track at the Cayman/Boxster Driving Experience, in the Speedway infield. A ten-dollar donation to Camp Boggy Creek was good for three laps of the tight little road course, two behind the wheel and one riding with an instructor from the Porsche Driving Experience.

If you are a Porsche fan who missed Rennsport Reunion III, mark your calendar now for Rennsport Reunion IV, the first weekend of November 2010. And hope that it happens!






